The planning cycle begins at the start of the fiscal year when annual assessments plans are prepared and reported for administrative units and for academic programs. Regular reviews of academic programs and administrative units are prepared to identify areas of priority and improvement. Every five years, the college reviews its mission, vision, and strategic goals in order to guide its integrated educational master plan (IEMP), which consists of plans from all areas of the college. These various plans are carried out and aspects of the plans are assessed by the annual assessment plans (i.e., program reviews at COM-FSM). These various cycles are reported to the college's accreditation commission every six years. From time to time, short-term, specific development plans are drawn to strategize accomplishing objectives specific to an area, such as communication, technology, etc. These individual plans feed into the institutional strategic plan which is annually monitored and adjusted.
