High school students who wish to apply for dual enrollment at the college must meet the following requirements:

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Grade Level and Grade Point Average (GPA)
 - Successfully completed the 11th grade.
 - Hold a minimum cumulative GPA of **3.50**, as certified by their principal or designee, or a director of a college program working with high school seniors
- 2. Justification Statement
 - A statement from the principal, designee, or a director of a college program working with high school seniors must be submitted, explaining how the student is academically, intellectually, or artistically prepared for college-level coursework.
- 3. Committee Recommendation
 - The college's Recruitment, Admissions, and Retention Committee (RARC) has recommended the student for dual enrollment.

Enrollment and Financial Responsibilities

- 1. Students must meet all course prerequisites and placement requirements before enrollment.
- 2. Credits and grades earned will appear on the student's college transcript.
- 3. Dual enrollment students are not eligible for US Federal Student Aid (FSA).
- 4. Students are responsible for paying tuition and matriculation fees at the standard rate for regular students.

Dual Enrollment and Regular College Admission

- 1. Dual enrollment does not guarantee regular admission to the college.
- 2. After high school graduation, students must complete the standard admission process to qualify for regular admission.

Application Process

Students must submit all required documents together in a single packet to the Office of Admissions, Records, and Retention (OARR):

- 1. Completed COM-FSM Application for Dual Enrollment
- 2. Recommendation letter from the principal or designee, or a director of a college program working with high school seniors
- 3. Proof of admission fee payment
- 4. Official high school transcript
