Applicants with a grade point average (GPA) below 2.0 from high school will not be admitted to the College unless they have had considerable job experience or training since high school and can furnish recommendations from prior training programs, agencies or employers. COM- FSM entrance test (COMET) scores will be given primary consideration for these applicants. Upon recommendation of the Committee on Recruitment, Admissions and Retention (RAR), the President may approve special admission.
