## Admission to Certificate of Achievement Programs

High school graduates and GED certificate holders who are not accepted into or are not interested in a degree program may apply for admission into an entry-level certificate of achievement program. Applicants must take the COMET, and be accepted by the President upon recommendation of the Committee on Recruitment, Admission and Retention. Acceptance is based on the applicant's score on the COMET, and other criteria as defined by the committee.

Applicants with significantly low scores on the COMET are ineligible for admission. Other certificate of achievement programs are offered when criteria for offering the program are met. Admission requirements vary with the program.
