Title: Special Admissions to Associate Programs

Students completing approved certificate programs with a “C” or better in the General Education and program core requirements will be admitted to the associated degree program without re-sitting COMET.

Definitions:

Approved certificate program – Curriculum Committee approved certificate program that has been modified with a guided pathway from the certificate to the associated degree program.

Associated degree program – any program that provides continued education in the same major field of study as the certificate program. An example is the Certificate of Agriculture and Food Technology and AS degree in Agriculture & Natural Resources Management.
