To be eligible for admission to the Third-Year Certificate of Achievement in Public Health Specialist program, applicants must meet one of the following admission criteria:

 Completed an associate degree in Public Health, AND earned a grade of "C" or better in each of the prescribed major requirements of the program, AND achieved a cumulative GPA (CumGPA) of at least 2.5 upon completion of the program,

-OR-

- Completed an associate degree in a health or science-related discipline (e.g., Health Career Opportunity Program, Nursing, Medical Technology, or similar fields), AND achieve a CumGPA of at least 2.5 upon completion of the program, AND completed all of the following prescribed prerequisite courses with a grade of "C" or better:
 - a. PH 101-Introduction to Public Health
 - b. PH 111-Introduction to Basic Epidemiology and Biostatistics
 - c. PH 121-Environmental Prevention and Control of Disease
 - d. PH 141-Principles of Health Promotion

-OR-

- 3. Completed an associate degree in a non-health or non-science-related discipline, AND achieve a CumGPA of at least 2.5 upon completion of the program, AND completed all of the following prescribed pre-requisite courses with a grade of "C" or better:
 - a. PH 101-Introduction to Public Health
 - b. PH 111-Introduction to Basic Epidemiology and Biostatistics
 - c. PH 121-Environmental Prevention and Control of Disease
 - d. PH 131-Food and Nutrition in the Life Cycle
 - e. PH 141-Principles of Health Promotion
 - f. PH 231-Food Nutrition and Lifestyle Diseases
