Transfer Students and Transfer Credits

Students who have earned satisfactory grades from another US regionally accredited college or university may apply for admission, and be given advanced standing at COM-FSM.

Students must submit to the college's Office of Admissions, Records and Retention (OARR) the following:

1. A completed Application for COM-FSM Admission form. Printable Application for COM-FSM Admission form may also be downloads from the college's website.
2. Proof of paying the \$10 admission fee.
3. An official copy of his/her high school transcript.
4. An official transcript from each college or university previously attended.

Credit for previous satisfactory college work can only be given upon receipt of previous college records. Students may also transfer credits earned at the college with grades of "C" or better.
