Request for Proposals for the SIS Project: Financial Aid Process Enhancements

Project Goals

- Provide technical expertise in the selection of a Learning Management System (LMS)
 with focus on the integration of the current Students' Information System with the LMS;
- Integrate/link the LMS data to the SIS to allow tracking and reporting of Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) at the individual student, course and institution levels.

Proposed Project Approach

This project aims to provide an interface that could be used to program the linkages between the LMS and the SIS. This type of linkage will allow the college to analyze SLO information at the student, course and individual levels on key indicators as required by new accreditation standards.

The Programmer shall work with the COM-FSM Director of Information Technology to select a Learning Management System that would:

- 1. Allow students to access in real time their status in each class based course level student learning outcomes;
- 2. Enable faculty to track student progress against SLOs and provide early warning options for underperforming students and help students to know if they are on track to excel in the course; and
- 3. Interface with the organization's student management system.
