- Building Maintenance and Repair – COA
- Masonry – COA
- Plumbing – COA
- Small Engine, Equipment and Outboard Motor Report – COA
- Public Health – Advanced COA
- Building Technology-Construction Electricity – Advanced COA
- Electronic Technology – Advanced COA
- Telecommunication – Advanced COA
