- 1. The Board approved the addition of a new section, section 6 Paternity Leave, for Section IX of the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.
- 2. The Board directed the administration to complete without delay the access road to the Chuuk Campus permanent site.
- 3. The modifications to the Associate of Science Degree Program in Business Administration were approved for implementation effective Fall 2010 semester.
- 4. The Board approved the extension of all courses of the Third-Year Certificate in Teacher Preparation Program (TYC-TP) to Chuuk, Kosrae, and Yap campuses on a needs basis in coordination with the national campus education division and following the established third-year admissions policies and procedures; implementation pending ACCJC approval.
- 5. The Board deferred action on the Memorandum of Understanding for articulation between Guam Community College and COM-FSM pending completion of the language for articulation of vocational programs.
- 6. The Board referred the recommended Sexual Harassment Policy for Students back to the administration for consideration of comments raised.
- 7. The resolution from the national campus faculty was transmitted to the administration for collaborative consideration and recommendation.
- 8. The minutes of the March 15-18, 2010, special meeting as amended were adopted.
