Office of Institutional Effectiveness & Quality Assurance (IEQA) COM-FSM Board Report

Accreditation

The National campus held an Accreditation Carnival on March 3, 2023 with the faculty, staff, and students with the purpose of familiarizing them with the accreditation process and the ACCJC Standards.

COM-FSM welcomed the Accreditation Team the week of March 13-17, 2023 for their focused site visit as required by ACCJC. The team was led by Dr. Rosevonne Pato as Chair, Dr. Ardis Eschenberg as Vice Chair, and members Dr. Peter Hepburn, Dr. Jill Bonds, Dr. Brian Sanders, Mr. Stevenson Kotton; and ACCJC staff liaison, Dr. Catherine Webb. Interviews on the seven (7) Core Inquiries were conducted with the college community members in addition to an open forum, and concluded their visit with an exit report. The exit report highlighted the following findings by the Visiting Team.

Commendations

- 1. Significant strength Support for diverse personnel, professional development & incentive programs, supporting growth & development for staff, employees and family members
- 2. Strategic use of funding sources and financial resources supports the response to student needs in a changing environment
- 3. Exemplary practice of outcomes assessment across six campuses in four states

Recommendations for improvement

- 1. Strengthen integration of short- and long-term plans for allocation of human, physical, technological, and financial resources to meet student needs in a post pandemic environment.
- 2. Improve its practices and systems for personnel evaluation and management as stated in the President's work plan and other plans

Information Technology

Network/Systems

Systems services were significantly affected due to uncontrollable island grid outages at Palikir site. The college experienced entire network systems downtimes last December due to a malfunctioned Automatic Transfer Switch. The Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) batteries in the primary server room located in the Admin building failed to withstand long hours without power thus forcing automatic shutdowns of the college's Mail and Internet servers. Other Application servers were also affected. An emergency meeting was held on December 27, 2022, by key management staff including the Maintenance Director, Comptroller, and IT & Security representatives. The group voted and agreed on the following solutions:

- Replace UPS Battery Backups in the Server Room.
- Borrow CTEC's Automatic Transfer Switch (ATS) to Admin Building's backup generator then order replacements and backups for both CTEC and National

Orders have been shipped, according to vendors.

The IT Office continues in its efforts of maintenance and expansion of systems to accommodate and support mission critical technology functions. All campuses continue usage of their internet services via ADSL, Single Mode Fiber optics and/or T1 technologies depending on location. With financial grant assistance from CaresAct, Satellite uplinks via Kacific Broadband Satellite (KBS) have been used as redundancy for all campuses except Yap, and main uplink for Kosrae Campus.

The college has been awarded a \$1.19 million grant to be used for network speed improvements at CTEC, Chuuk, Yap, and FMI campuses and to continue using the KBS services as redundancy. ITO is now working to revise the remaining two years of its current contract with FSMTC to reflect the following new rates.

Instructional Support Equipment

Campuses have received their new SMARTBoard equipment. Most campuses have already installed their SMARTBoards in designated <u>locations</u> including classrooms, computer labs, conference rooms, etc.

Computer Labs

All computer labs are equipped with new computers and SMARTBoards at all campuses except National campus Business Computer. The lab required special hardware therefore needed a different RFQ. The bidding was closed and PPMO is currently working on a contract for the winning bidder.

Student Database, Student Information System (SIS)

SIS functionality is functional. IT continues to work with Office of Admissions Records and Retention (OARR) and Instructional for further reporting modifications and capabilities. SIS data synchronization with Canvas portal has been functional. Instructional and Student records are automatically pushed to Canvas.

Email

ITO is still promoting the use of our new EDU email, with the hope of transitioning to the new email by Summer 2023. A Google Alias domain has been created and tested for such purposes. ITO is targeting the transition when there is less user/traffic.

HelpDesk
