Procedure: BP 4913

Date Adopted:

Students seeking to be admitted and register to an associate degree program by completing approved certificate programs must complete an Application for Admission to Associate Degree Program & Course Selection Form.

Steps:

- 1. Obtain an Application for Admission to Associate Degree & Course Selection Form from the college Office of Admissions, Records and Retention (OARR).
- 2. Fill up information on the form and secure endorsement/approval from Dean of Academic Program or Instructional Coordinator and Vice President of Instructional Affairs or Campus Dean or Campus Director.
- 3. Return the form to OARR for filing or to continue with registration steps if approved.

Conditions:

- 1. The certificate program completed was earned from the College of Micronesia FSM.
- 2. The certificate program completed should be from the academic term where the approved certificate program was implemented. If the certificate program completed was prior to the implementation of the approved certificate program curriculum, BP 4202 Admissions to Associate Programs & AP 4000 applies where in the student need to be on degree placement through the college placement test.
- 3. Students who completed approved certificate programs could only be admitted on the associated degree program. If students wish to be admitted on other than the associated degree program, BP 4202 & AP 4000 apply.
