Review of Board Policies 4914 (Sexual Misconduct Policy for Students), and 4901 (Sexual Harassment Policy for Students).

RECOMMENDED DIRECTIVE:

The Board hereby approves: (a) Board Policies 44914 (Sexual Misconduct Policy for Students); and (b) the deletion of Board Policy 4901 (Sexual Harassment Policy for Students).

DISCUSSION

Policies and procedures are living documents designed to adapt to the evolving nature of an organization. While the core principles of a policy may endure, the specific details should be adaptable and responsive to the organization's shifts. Consequently, the Vice President for Enrollment Management and Student Services (VPEMSS) consistently engages in collaboration and coordination with pertinent EMSS offices and standing committees within the college to assess policies and procedures related to enrollment management and student services (Chapter 4).

After having been endorsed by the Student Success Committee (SSC)¹, the Executive Committee reviewed and endorsed for approval by the Board of Regents on November 21, 2023, the following:

1. Board Policy 4914 (Sexual Misconduct Policy for Students). This new policy takes precedence, supersedes and revokes BP No. 4901 (Sexual Harassment Policy for Students); and
2. Deletion of Board Policy 4901 (Sexual Harassment Policy for Students).
