Information Technology

IT continues to work toward improving the overall COM-FSM technology system.

Networks

Networks: IT is actively pursuing potential options to make existing networks faster and therefore services we offer more effective. Talks continue with our primary internet service provider for changes to the National campus link speed, the Pohnpei campus link type, the Kosrae campus link type, the Chuuk campus link type and the Yap campus link type. We are close to agreeing to the new terms, and details have been shared with relevant leadership at the College. As it stands now, after all is in place, Yap, Chuuk and Kosrae campuses will terminate usage of T1 lines and switch primary connections for internet services to DSL a type link at rates of 1537/768 kbps each. Pohnpei campus will also switch to a DSL link also at 1537/768 kbps but their T1 utilization will remain for overhead and local connection needs for e-mail and SIS. FMI campus will retain their T1 link to Yap campus as their primary internet service line. The link type change is to take advantage of DSL type technologies recently made available at these locations: DSL type technologies are better able to handle noisy copper lines used by our service provider that may reduce link speed in some cases. Negotiations continue for price details of a second DSL type connection at a lower data rate for Yap, Chuuk and Kosrae campuses for VoIP traffic only, in order to separate it from other internet traffic for improved throughput of data over the connection. Current internet speeds for Yap, Chuuk and Kosrae campuses over T1 lines are at 1024 kbps asymmetric. In conjunction to these changes and necessary to be able to make use of these changes, IT has been purchasing more smart switches to be able to better control capabilities on existing networks. Cost for the changes are currently estimated to be approximately \$2000 more per month compared to the service contract.

Wireless expansion project

Wireless expansion project update: All pilot project sites are functioning well. COM-FSM's wireless network community continues to grow. Our tracking data shows students and staff alike are increasingly making use of our wireless option for their network needs. IT continues to focus on wireless network security and expansion of wireless network hotspots at all locations where this pilot project has been successfully implemented. COM-FSM's Wireless network security that is currently in place allows us to limit maximum bandwidth usage per user, limitation of non-sanctioned bandwidth usage per user, authentication of authorized users, time limits for authorized users, and malicious code blockage. (in case a user's device has a virus trying to infect the rest of our network). Currently, explorations into more permanent industrial size antennas for mounting WiFi equipment are being considered for all sites.

Electronic Information Panel Project

Electronic Information Panel Project: This effort included first steps on tasks identified in SIS Phase III, so far the units that are up and functional have received good reviews and seem to be functioning well as an information sharing medium. The panel incorporates data from the Campus News forms sourced in the SIS backend database. Work done by IT has allowed for DCR as well as trained campus representatives at

each campus to be able to supply news and information for dissemination to their students through the myShark website portal and these Information Panels.

*The panels display class schedule, current time, and pictures and live COM-FSM news postings inclusive of emergency information.

WebSite

WebSite improvements efforts continue. IT continues collaboration efforts different units to accommodate website updates and relevancy. The effort is to further improve the website by improving the speed and accuracy of news content from our sites to their constituents as well as to a broader audience. The website CMS setup is functioning as designed, the college is currently running the COM-FSM website on drupal version 6. We still are not able to go up to version 7 because the PHP version used on the www server is at 5.1, drupal 7 requires PHP 5.2 or higher. Upgrading to PHP 5.2 breaks our current webmail application, but we appear to have overcome that obstacle and are preparing to make changes to our hardware and software we use for webmail in order to accommodate the change. Because of some very affective research and testing, we averted having to make a costly change our webmail client by making some important changes to our existing setup.+

Google Analytics Report

The COM-FSM news feeds are up in readership as trending demonstrates beginning from November 01, 2011 to February 20, 2013. Within that time period a total of 1,881,603 page views occurred on the college's website, where 3.65% (68,734) of those page views were on the news feeds. Beginning August 2012 to date, the page views per month averaged close to 5,000. The month of November 2012 logged the most page views ever at a total of 6,183 views. The periods between semesters see a decline in readership, but regains upward momentum as school begins. President Daisy's Investiture Address remains the top viewed news item at 674 page views since it was posted in February of 2012. Second to that would be the announcement of his appointment as president.

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SIS Developments

SIS Developments: The progress on work towards the goals of the COM-FSM SIS phase III contract continues. As mentioned in the accreditation report, the SIS is a step in the right direction and has allowed for many positives for the COM-FSM, but they encourage us to continue the efforts. The Developer will be visiting onsite in April of 2013. The visit will be to implement major changes in software to the base Database code for the SIS, therefore much is on hold awaiting the visit.

As per the terms of the contract no. ct11-0459/enc11.0401 and as specified in the details of the SIS phase III contract, the following is an update of work done so far:

1. The Migration of the MySQL database server to new faster hardware is now 100% complete. The previous system has been switched off; the full migration was a big task and was successful.
2. Campus-managed announcement and news items for display in the COM-FSM myShark portal and other locations such as the COM-FSM web site and information panels is progressing on schedule. 99% complete but not in production yet.
3. Online Registration efforts continue.
 - Implementation planning (procedural changes and policy development) 50%
 - Software development 40%
4. E-Mail distribution by campus or other grouping work is 90% complete, currently stalled
 - To be used for sending emergency notices or other high-priority messages
5. Course schedule planning and projection (work in progress)
6. Wait-listing capabilities (work in progress)
 - Implementation planning (procedural change and policy development)
 - Software development to follow

IT successfully completed trainings for faculty regarding specific communications best practices and options available to them for space on the COM-FSM web server for academic purposes to host content for their students.
