# Agenda/Major Topics of Discussion:

Interim President called the meeting to Order and read the college's mission statement. VPAS moved and VPEMSS seconded that Cabinet adopts the above meeting agenda. Motion carried.

# **Approval of Minutes**

• Minutes of April 14, 2021 – Cabinet reviewed the minutes of April 14, 2021, meeting. VPEMSS moved VPAS seconded that Cabinet adopts the minutes. Motion passed.

#### **Old Business**

- <u>WeCare Scholarship</u> Cabinet is to determine final amount of cost of scholarship, looking again at application regarding who will be eligible and the screening process. By June 01, 2021 notice will be sent out to the students utilizing any means to get word out including the radio.
- <u>Free Laptop Program</u> the proposed quantity is 550 laptops. The recommendation is to purchase 350 from Dell and 100 Chrome books and 100 from comfsm bookstore. Laptops from the bookstore should be Dell version with at least one year quarantee and no mark ups from cost value. After discussions, VPAS moved and VPEMSS seconded that Cabinet approve to purchase 550 Dell laptops only with the same specifications. Motion carried with one abstention.

# **New Business**

- <u>Incentive Awards</u> –Discussion included review and thoughts on each nomination processes; concern over the low number of responses to the process; the lack of variety of reasons to merit each award and merits to authenticate college's core values. Cabinet's consensus is to have VPAS work with HRO Director to improve the current Incentive Award processes and authenticate merits for next year's incentive awards.
  - <u>a)</u> <u>Innovative Award</u> None. Cabinet felt there was not enough reasons to support nominations.
  - b) Award of Recognitions- Arleen Yamaguchi is the recipient of this year's award
  - c) <u>Faculty of the Year</u> Brian Lynch is the recipient of this year's award.
  - <u>d)</u> <u>Community Services Award</u> Shaun Suliol and Christopher Gilmete are the recipients of this year's award
  - e) <u>Staff of the Year</u> Maria Dison is the recipient of this year's award.

- <u>Custodian Positions</u> VPAS sought Cabinet's endorsement and support for two custodian positions. One for CTEC and one for Yap Campus. To give proper review and thought to the request, Cabinet postponed taking action at this time. Cabinet will do review and take action electronically.
- <u>Committee Attendance</u>—Cabinet shared concern over committee attendance of three or more absences in committee meetings without notice to committee officers. A list has been shared with each vice presidents. Supervisors are to issue written warning to those who missed three or more meetings.
- <u>End of Year Self</u>-Evaluation survey Just a heads up that the survey is coming around to please complete it.
- <u>Commencement</u> Spring 2021 Commencement will be a drive-through ceremony on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. So far we have 130 candidates for graduation. Interim President will deliver a commencement address to the graduates during the drive through. EMSS is also planning a college wide virtual commencement sometimes in May for Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 graduates.

Interim President recapped and encouraged we get moving and complete all previously approved projects under the CARES ACT funding. Vice Presidents should after each Cabinet meeting take note of actions and decisions regarding projects or tasks in their department are moving to ensure timely completion of projects. She will send the list of those approved projects to vice presidents by next week.

VPAS moved and VPEMSS seconded that Cabinet adjourned. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 4:54 p.m.
