

Chuuk Campus offers a number programs: (1) 3rd-Year Certificate in Teacher Preparation; (2) A.A. Degree in Teacher Preparation, (3) Certificate in Bookkeeping, (4) Certificate in Secretarial Science, (5) Certificate in Pre-Nursing Assistance, and (6) Certificate in Basic Public Health. A seventh program will begin in Fall 2019: B.S. Degree in Elementary Education.

and another in English as well as two part-time tutors in other subjects. OUR FIVE CORE VALUES: Think Acronym C-L-E-P-T An Open Message to Administrators, Faculty, and Other Staff

<u>C</u>ommitment, <u>L</u>earner-centeredness, <u>E</u>xcellence, <u>P</u>rofessionalism, and <u>T</u>eamwork — the five COM-FSM core values. Last year (2017) our Board of Regents approved the values as the <u>quintessence</u> of <u>our</u> performance of duties and responsibilities. <u>Whose</u> performance? Administrators, faculty, and other staff, of course!

However, fact may **belie** truth. During our 2018 Spring Semester, 54 employees took a survey on how well they perceived themselves in performing these core values. On a Likert scale from "strongly agree" to "strongly disagree", the cumulative results reveal less-than-strong agreement. Percentages of "strongly agree" were 44% Professionalism, 41% Teamwork, 34% Learner-Centeredness, 31% Excellence, and only 29% Commitment.

What do these results really reveal? (1) 56% <u>not</u> as strongly **professional** as they should be. (2) 59% <u>not</u> as strongly involved in **teamwork** as they should be. (3) 66% <u>not</u> as strongly **learner-centered** as they should be. (4) 69% <u>not</u> as **excellent** as they should be. (5) <u>WORSE OF ALL, 71% not as strongly **committed**</u> as they should be.

Before we **admonish** our students, we the administrators, faculty, and other staff should look at ourselves in the mirror first. The faces which we see may not be as capable as we want to perceive ourselves. Rather, we may be **culpable** of not reflecting quality. Let us truly work to achieve CLEPT — our five core values. We can do it. Θ
