- Review and Discussions for the WASC Level II Assessment training by Dr. Amy Driscoll The presentation from Dr. Driscoll was entitled Why Learning Outcomes? A Scholarly Response. It covers the why, what and how of student learning outcomes from student, faculty and institutional support angles and provided the basic research supporting the learning outcomes approach. Most is not all of the issues addressed by the presentation are covered in detail in the college's Institutional Assessment Handbook located on the IRPO web site.
 - The Chair would encourage all members to share Dr. Driscoll's presentation with their campuses or areas they represent.
