Admissions Criteria Third-Year Programs

- 1. Associate Degree Criteria
 - a. Student can take up to two courses without officially admitted into the program.
 - b. Student has to be admitted to go further (take up to three or more courses)
- 2. GPA Criteria
 - a. 2.75 CumGPA Minimum (Students with CumGPA below 2.75 will be reviewed and considered by the sub-committee.)
- 3. Balance Criteria
 - a. Clear account
- 4. Pre-requisite Criteria
 - a. ED 210a, ED 215 and ED/PY 201 for third-year in Teacher Preparation
 - b. ED 210a, ED 215 and ED/PY 201 for third-year in Special Education
- 5. Essay Criteria: (applicable to all applicants)

A three member sub-committee whose members are the Education Division Chairperson, Magdalena Hallers and Sylvia Henry will represent the Division to review third-year applications along with the representatives from Admissions Board and OAR.
