

Business Division's Goals and Programs

One of the division's key goal is the development of private sector so as to promote national economic self-sufficiency/self-reliance. Hence, it offers three programs that are in-line with that goal, namely, **Business Administration, Computer Information System and Accounting.**

The Division offers two type of degrees, namely, Associate of Science degree and Third-year Certificate of Achievement. The former aims to provide an individual entry-level skills, and foundational knowledge of their choice of field and as well as to upgrade skills or provide a stepping stone for a higher degree that they want to pursue. The latter aims to provide higher level skills and as well preparations toward fourth-year programs elsewhere.

The third year program is articulated with the University of Guam, so students can transfer smoothly from COM-FSM into the fourth and final year at that university.
