Enrollment at COM FSM for two years to help you earn an Associate degree in Liberal Arts.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- = A GPA of no less than 2.90.
- = A TOEFL score of 550

FINANCIAL AID:

Round-trip airfare from your home island to Pohnpei is provided.

Student must apply for financial aid, such as the Pell Grant, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Work Study Program, and the State Scholarship, To cover tuition, fees, and food and lodging.

Board: \$1,100.76 (3 meals/day)
\$ 315.00 (Lunch, a semester)

Fees: \$50.00 to \$100.00


The following list is only a partial listing of health occupations and positions needed in Micronesia. Some of these occupations may require only one or two years while a Doctor of Medicine may require ten years.
