Dear Colleagues,

We have made verifications of the existing personnel to ensure we account for all personnel, housing and all fixed costs. We believe we have taken care of allocations for all of these items. Left for each VPs, offices and programs is to meet with their respective programs and units and allocate the rest of the remaining \$755,546 for Travel, contractual services, OCE, and fixed assets. This has to be done immediately as we can meet the budget deadline.

- 1. Call a meeting of your programs and office heads and allocate portion of your share of the remaining balance to all of your priorities within you respective units.
- Complete your workbooks that we have prepared for you. Copies of those will be sent to you by Sinobu and Francis.
- 3. Work on your performance worksheet to correspond to the figures.
- 4. We will zero out all of your column on travel, special services contract, OCE, and fixed assets and then you need to fill them in with your new line items budgeting. Please be reminded that you will link all of these planning with your IEMP, new strategic directions, and the results of your assessment reports 2012-13.
- 5. We have up until next week Friday to complete this work. We would like to respectively ask of you to stick with this deadline, please.
- 6. Since PRC and Finance Committee are already joining us in the development and planning of the budget, I believe its proper to send it directly to EC.
- 7. We will compile this and get it ready for EC to endorse it to the President and the BOR.
- 8. Our staff need time to compile the budget for the BOR.

Attached, please find the spreadsheet on the allocation Ratio. The second tap shows how much is determined for each office to allocate to the rest of their Travel, Contractual Services, OCE, and Fixed Assets. This ratio is based on the remaining budget requests, all campus, vs. the remaining available budget after we have allocated all fixed costs and all personnel+ benefit costs to Scenario #4.

On the first tap (table in green) shows how much we saved from removing all vacancies from all campus personnel + benefit (using 65% ratio in personnel).

I note that all VPs are still out but I ask humbly that we begin the process right away. The good news is that the budget is balanced based on very safe budget projections that can help us in the long run. We will need to focus on strategic planning during this fiscal year to achieve a better 2015 funding level.
