02. How many miles is it from Pohnpei to the north pole?

03. How many miles is it from Pohnpei to the south pole?

04. A boat is in the ocean 700 miles due north of Pohnpei. What is the latitude of the boat?

05. The Avon Isles near Australia lie 19° south of the equator and are due south of Pohnpei. How many kilometers from Pohnpei are the Avon Isles?

06. A pizza with a diameter of 14 inches is cut into 5 equally sized pieces. What is the length of the crust on one piece?
